2 ORDINANCE NO. 1005

3 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING GENERAL PENALTY  
4 PROVISIONS.

5 Section 1.

6 (a) Any person violating any of the provisions or  
7 failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of the  
8 ordinances of the County of Calaveras, shall be guilty of a mis-  
9 demeanor, unless the violation is made an infraction by  
10 ordinance.

11 (b) Except in cases where a different punishment is  
12 prescribed by any ordinance of the County of Calaveras, any per-  
13 son convicted of a misdemeanor for violation of an ordinance of  
14 the County is punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred  
15 dollars, or by imprisonment not to exceed six months, or by  
16 both such fine and imprisonment.

17 (c) Any person convicted of an infraction for viola-  
18 tion of an ordinance of the County of Calaveras, is punishable  
19 by (1) a fine not exceeding fifty dollars for a first violation;  
20 (2) a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars for a second viola-  
21 tion of the same ordinance within one year; (3) a fine not exceed-  
22 ing two hundred fifty dollars for each additional violation of  
23 the same ordinance within one year.

24 (d) Each such person shall be guilty of a separate  
25 offense for each and every day during any portion of which any  
26 violation of any provision of the ordinances of the County of  
27 Calaveras, is committed, continued or permitted by any such  
28 person, and he shall be punishable accordingly.

CALAVERAS COUNTY

1           Effective Date. This Ordinance shall, before the  
2 expiration of fifteen (15) days after the passage of the same,  
3 be published with the names of the members of the Board of  
4 Supervisors voting for and against the same, for at least one  
5 week in a newspaper printed and published in the County of  
6 Calaveras, State of California, and shall take effect and be in  
7 force from and after thirty (30) days after the passage of the  
8 same.

9           The foregoing Ordinance was duly passed and adopted this
