

Ordinance No 102 X

Granting to the Emery Gold Mining and Water Company, a Corporation, The Right of Way, Privilege and Franchise to Construct, Maintain and Operate a Telephone, Telegraph, and Electric Power Line from the Town of San Andreas to the Town of El Dorado, and through said Town and Townsite to the Reservoir and Ditch Plant of said Corporation, in Calaveras County, California.

The Board of Supervisors of Calaveras County do ordain as follows:

-: Section 1:-

The right, privilege, and franchise is hereby granted to the Emery Gold Mining and Water Company, a corporation, its successors and assigns, to construct, maintain, use and operate, in Calaveras County, and in and upon and along the highways, roads, avenues, thoroughfares, streets, lanes, byways and public grounds of the Towns of said County hereinafter mentioned, such poles, masts, wires, and other appliances and conductors, either by over-head or underground system, for the maintenance of and construction of a telephone, telegraph and electric power line from the Town of San Andreas to the Town of El Dorado, and through said Town of El Dorado to the Reservoir and ditch system of said Corporation, near the said Town of El Dorado, all in the said County of Calaveras.

-: Section 2:-

The poles, masts, conductors, and other appliances for supporting said telephone, telegraph and electric power wires above the surface of the roads, avenues, streets, highways, thoroughfares and other public grounds of the said County of Calaveras, and in the said Towns thereof, shall be so constructed and maintained as to cause no interference with public comfort or convenience.

-: Section 3:-

That the said poles, masts, conductors and other appliances for the suspension of said telegraph, telephone and electric power wires in, over and along any highways, avenues, streets, public thoroughfares or other public grounds in the said County of Calaveras, shall be placed set and maintained in position under the supervision of the Board of Supervisors of Calaveras County, or their authorized agent or representative.

-: Section 4:-

The rights, privileges and franchises hereby granted shall run in favor of said Emery Gold Mining and Water Company, its successors and assigns, and shall continue and be in full force for the period of Fifty

gave from and after the date of approval of the Ordinance  
 of the City of New York that the franchise herein  
 granted shall in no way be construed to be an exclusive  
 franchise, right or privilege to the said City or to any  
 and other company, its successors and assigns, of the  
 rights herein granted, and shall in no way be construed  
 to prevent the granting of similar rights, franchises and  
 franchises to other persons.

Section 5.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force  
 fifteen days from and after its passage, and before taking  
 effect shall be published for six weeks in the "Gazette"  
 of the City, and a weekly newspaper published in said City  
 County.
