AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 945
CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION FROM
Unclassified TO
Rural Residential 5 acre minimum.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF CALAVERAS,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, does ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION I:

That the Zoning Ordinance of Calaveras County No. 945
is hereby amended to change the zoning classification from "U" District,
Unclassified to RRB5 District, Rural Residential
5 acre minimum for the following described property also known as
Sectional Zoning Amendment: G, b, 745:

and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, it

against the same in the Prospect, a newspaper of general circulation
printed and published in the County of Calaveras.
