

Ordinance No 103. X

Granting to Desire Fricot the Right of Way, Privilege, and Franchise to Construct, Maintain and Operate a Telephone Telegraph and Electric Power Line from the Town of San Andreas To and Through the Village of Calaveritas, To the Mining Claims of Said Desire Fricot, in Calaveras County, California.

The Board of Supervisors of Calaveras County do ordain as follows:

Section 1:-

The right, privilege and franchise is hereby granted to Desire Fricot, his successors and assigns, to construct, maintain, use and operate, in Calaveras County, and in and upon and along the highways, roads, avenues, thoroughfares, streets, lanes, by-ways and public grounds of the Towns of said County hereinafter mentioned, such poles, masts, wires, and other appliances and conductors, either by over-head or under-ground system, for the maintenance of and construction of a telephone, telegraph, and electric power line from the Town of San Andreas to and through the village of Calaveritas, to the mining claims of said Desire Fricot on San Antonio Ridge, about Six Miles from the said Village of Calaveritas, all in the said County of Calaveras.

Section 2:-

The poles, masts, conductors and other appliances for supporting said telephone, telegraph and electric power wires above the surface of the roads, avenues, streets, highways, thoroughfares and other public grounds of the said County of Calaveras, and in the said Towns thereof, shall be so constructed and maintained as to cause no interference with Public comfort or convenience

Section 3:-

That the said poles, masts, conductors and other appliances for the suspension of said telegraph, telephone and electric power wires in, over and along any highways, avenues, streets, public thoroughfares or other public grounds in the said County of Calaveras, shall be placed, set and maintained in position under the supervision of the Board of Supervisors of Calaveras County, or their authorized agent or representative.

Section 4:-

The rights, privileges and franchises hereby granted shall run in favor of said Desire Fricot, his successors and assigns, and shall continue and be in full force for the period of Fifty years from and after the date of approval of this Ordinance. It is expressly understood that the privileges herein

granted shall in no way be construed to be an exclusive franchise, right or privilege to the said Desire Ernst his successors or assigns, of the rights herein granted, and shall in no way be construed to prevent the granting of similar rights, privileges and franchises to other purposes.

Section 5:-

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force Fifteen days from and after its passage, and before taking effect shall be published for one week in the "Kalauerac Chronicle" a weekly newspaper published in said Kalauerac County.
