

## Ordinance No. 104. X

Amending Ordinance No. 71 of the Board of Supervisors of Calaveras County, passed and approved on the 9th day of July, 1896.  
The Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras, do order as follows:

Sec. 1. That a new sub-division entitled subdivision 13 A. be added to section two of ordinance No. 71 of the Board of Supervisors of Calaveras County, imposing license tax in the County of Calaveras, providing for the collection of the same, and imposing a penalty for the violation thereof, to read as follows:

13 A. For the business of hawking or auctioneering (other than official work) or selling upon the street or indoors by public, any jewelry or ware of precious metals, or gold or silver plated ware, the sum of twenty dollars per day.

Sec. 2. This ordinance before taking effect shall be published for one week in the Calaveras Chronicle, a newspaper printed and published in said County, and shall take effect on the 26th day of January, 1901.
