AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 945
CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION FROM
"U" Unclassified

TO "RR-3" Rural Residential - 3 Acre Minimum

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF CALAVERAS,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION I:

That the Zoning Ordinance of Calaveras County No. 945
is hereby amended to change the zoning classification from "U"
Unclassified to "RR-3" Rural Residential -
3 Acre Minimum for the following described
property also known as Sectional Zoning Amendment ZA #836 :

Boston-Yale Ranch Subdivision; portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4,
and Section 5, T5N, R12E, the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, T6N, R12E.
Two miles east of Mokelumne Hill.
AP# 14-001-13 and 16-018-03. Only that land included in Boston-Yale Subdivision
Unit #1, Tract 293

SECTION II:

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the
expiration of thirty (30) days from and after its passage, and it shall become
effective on the 2nd day of January 19 79, and before
the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, it shall be published
in the County of Calaveras.
