

Ordering Sewa Road Cell Tax, and a penalty
for the non-payment of the same.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of
Calaveras, do return as follows:

The sum of two dollars, providing the same
is paid before the first Monday of July, 1901.

But if not paid before the first Monday of July,
1901, then it shall be two dollars, as a last

cell tax, for the year 1901, to be collected by the
County Clerks as provided by Chapter 15, Part

III of the Critical Code of the State of California,
in which said Code are made provisions

twenty one and under fifty-five years of age,
in the County of Calaveras, State of California.

Nothing all persons who are hereby
discharged from service in the army or navy

of the United States, at any time within
the first day of April, 1861 and the first

day of September, 1865, and persons who have
not been exempted, who may be found in each

road district, who have not before said the
same in some other district, the same must

be collected. If any person assessed for a
property tax has not paid the same, the

road toll-tax due from him or her for
said, it with 3 3/4 percent in addition thereto.

shall constitute a lien upon the property
assessed to such person, which lien to attach

before the first Monday of March, 1901, and
which is collected in the same manner and

at the same time as other delinquent taxes
are collected.

On the first Monday of July, 1901, the County
must return to the Clerk all two-dollar

taxes and cell-tax, which were received by him
and not used, and pay to the Treasurer the

total amount collected, and not before said
into the treasury of the County Treasurer

to Section 3753 of the Critical Code of
California, the amount of his full gain.

The Auditor must transmit before the same
the three-dollar and full-tax receipts.

On the last Monday of December, 1901, the Auditor must return to the Auditor all three-dollar road poll-tax receipts received by him and not used, and must at the same time make final settlement with the Auditor thereof.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after the 15th day of February, 1901, and before taking effect shall be published for one week in the Salaveral Chronicle, a weekly newspaper printed and published in the said County of Salaveral.
