Ordinance No. 106. X

Amending Ordinance No. 41, of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras, passed and approved on the 9th day of July, 1896.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a new subdivision, entitled Subdivision 26th, be and the same is hereby added to Section Two of Ordinance No. 41 of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras, State of California, imposing license taxes in the County of Calaveras, providing for the collection of the same, and imposing a penalty for the violation thereof, passed and approved on the 9th day of July, 1896, and which said Subdivision 26th, shall read as follows:

26th. For the business of hiring, renting or leasing twenty-five telephones or over in said County of Calaveras, fifty dollars per quarter.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and including the 1st day of April, 1901, and before taking effect shall be published for one week in the Calaveras Chronicle, a newspaper printed and published in said County of Calaveras.

Section 3. The foregoing ordinance was passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the said County of Calaveras, at a regular session of said Board, on this 6th day of March, A.
