AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 945
CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION FROM
"A1"
General Agriculture
TO "RR-20"
Rural Residential - 20 Acre Minimum

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF CALAVERAS,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION I:

That the Zoning Ordinance of Calaveras County No. 945
is hereby amended to change the zoning classification from "A1"
General Agriculture to "RR-20" Rural Residential -
20 Acre Minimum for the following described
property also known as Sectional Zoning Amendment ZA 853:

For Melvin Road, located on a portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section
10, T4N, R10E, MDBM. General vicinity of Paloma Road near Camp Seco.
AP# 48-002-057.

SECTION II:

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the
expiration of thirty (30) days from and after its passage, and it shall become
effective on the 31st day of January 1979, and before
the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, it shall be published
in the County of Calaveras.
