

Granting to Joseph Oneto the Franchise, Right, Privilege and permission to maintain as a Toll Road and collect, receive and take tolls on that certain public highway situated in the County of Calaveras, State of California, commonly known as and called the Murphys and Altaville Turnpike Road, and being that road commencing at the town of Altaville, in said Calaveras County, and running thence to the town of Murphys in said County, along the Western side of Angels Creek, and being about 6 1/2 miles in length, for the period of ten (10) years from and after the date of this Ordinance.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby found by this Board and declared that the expense necessary to operate and maintain that certain public highway commonly known as and called the Murphys and Altaville Turnpike Road, and being that certain road commencing at the town of Altaville in said Calaveras County, and running thence to the Town of Murphys, in said County, along the Western side of Angels Creek, and being about six and one-half miles in length as a free public highway, is to great to justify the County of Calaveras in so operating or maintaining the same.

Section 2. Joseph Oneto of Calaveras County, California, his heirs or assigns, are hereby granted the franchise, right, privilege and permission to maintain as a Toll Road and to collect, receive and take tolls on that certain road and highway situated in the County of Calaveras, State of California, commonly known as and called the Murphys and Altaville Turnpike Road, and being that certain road commencing at the town of Altaville, in said County, and running thence to the town of Murphys, in said County, along the Western side of Angels Creek, and being about six and one-half miles in length.

Section 3. That the rates of toll that may be collected on said road by said Joseph Oneto under this license and franchise, shall be fixed and regulated each year at the first regular meeting of this Board in the month of July of each year, commencing in July, 1901.

Section 4. The license, franchise, permission, privilege

and right to collect tolls upon said public highway is hereby granted to the said Joseph Oneto upon the express condition attached thereto that said road shall be kept in reasonable repair by the said Joseph Oneto his heirs or assigns, during the continuance and term of said franchise, and that the said Joseph Oneto shall be required to sprinkle and water said road during the dry seasons and when water can be obtained.

Section 5. The place on said road where a toll gate shall be located under this license and franchise is hereby fixed at the gate at the dwelling house of Joseph Oneto, near the Town of Murphy, where a toll gate has in previous years been located on said road, and the said Joseph Oneto is hereby authorized to erect and maintain at toll gate at said place under this license and franchise, that the right is hereby reserved to the Board of Supervisors to change said toll gate or to erect such other toll gates at other points along said road as shall be deemed proper or necessary by the Board of Supervisors of Calaveras County.

Section 6. The franchise, right, privilege and permission hereby granted is granted to said Joseph Oneto for the term of Ten (10) years from and after the date of this Ordinance.

Section 7. The said Joseph Oneto grantee of said franchise, shall file with the County Clerk of the County of Calaveras, Ex-Officio Clerk of the Board of Supervisors thereof, within thirty (30) days after the date of the passage of this Ordinance, his written acceptance of this Ordinance and of all the provisions thereof.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force fifteen (15) days from and after the date of its passage.

Ordinance No. 108. X  
 Repealing Ordinance No. 106, passed and approved March 6<sup>th</sup>, 1901, and amending Ordinance No. 71, passed and approved on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1896, of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 106 of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras passed and approved on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1901, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That a new subdivision, entitled "Subdivision 26<sup>th</sup>", be and the same is hereby added to Section Two of Ordinance No. 71 of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Calaveras, imposing license taxes in the County of Calaveras, providing for the collection of the same, and imposing a penalty for the violation thereof, passed and approved on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1896, and which said subdivision 26<sup>th</sup> shall read as follows:

26<sup>th</sup>. For the business of hiring, renting or leasing twenty five telephones or over in said County of Calaveras twenty five dollars per quarter.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and including the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1901, and before taking effect shall be published for one week in the Calaveras Citizen, a newspaper printed and published in said County of Calaveras.

Section 4. The foregoing ordinance was passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the said County of Calaveras at a regular session of said Board on this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 1901, by the following vote:
