

# Ordinance No. 11. X

17

Any Ordinance to provide for the appointment of three viewers to view and survey a proposed alteration of an old road, and the opening of a new road, petitioned for by O. C. Wyllie and others.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Colveras California, do ordain, as follows: That Harry Witter, J. Galindo and A. H. Crotter (surveyors) be, and they are hereby appointed viewers to view and survey a proposed alteration of the public road leading from San Andreas to North Branch Post Office by way of McLurk's Bridge, and to view and survey a new road, as follows, to wit: said new road to commence at the easterly end of said McLurk's Bridge on the east bank of the North Fork of the Colveras River at the point where the said Bridge meets the County Road, thence in a southerly course along said east bank of said River taking a practicable grade for a distance of about one quarter of a mile or to a point where a practicable crossing can be made of said river, thence from said crossing in the most practicable and direct route in a westerly direction to the said County road on the westerly side of said river, being a total distance of about one half mile more or less; said road to be 40 feet wide.

The proposed alteration of said Public road being to abandon that portion of said road comprising at the easterly end of said McLurk's Bridge, and extending across said Bridge past the dwelling house of said McLurk down said road on the westerly side of said river to the point where the new proposed road unites with said County road on the westerly side of said river.

The viewers to meet at the residence of Harry Witter on Monday, the 26th day of October,

1885, at 10 o'clock A. M., and reports to this Board  
on Monday, November 2, 1885.
