AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 945
CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION FROM
Rural Residential 5 acre min.

TO Rural Residential 20 acre min.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF CALAVERAS,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION I:

That the Zoning Ordinance of Calaveras County No. 945
is hereby amended to change the zoning classification from "RR-5" Rural
Residential 5 acre min. to "RR-20" Rural
Residential 20 acre min. for the following described
property also known as Sectional Zoning Amendment 914 :

James Lee DeYoung
Southern portion of Assessors Parcel #14-009-10

SECTION II:

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the
expiration of thirty (30) days from and after its passage, and it shall become
effective on the 16th day of May 1979, and before
the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, it shall be published
in the County of Calaveras.
