Prohibiting the running at large of hogs upon uninclosed lands or public roads, streets, lanes, squares and alleys of towns, townsites and villages in the County of Calaveras.

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner of any hog or hogs or of any one who has the charge or care of any hog or hogs to knowingly allow such hog or hogs to run at large upon any of the uninclosed lands or on public roads, streets, lanes, squares or alleys of any town, townsite or village in the County of Calaveras.

Sec. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of January, 1904, and before taking effect shall be published for one week in the Calaveras Prospect, a weekly newspaper published in said County.
