AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 945  
CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION FROM  
U, Unclassified

TO RR-20, Rural Residential, 20 acre  
minimum

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF CALAVERAS,  
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION I:

That the Zoning Ordinance of Calaveras County No. 945  
is hereby amended to change the zoning classification from U  
to RR-20  
for the following described  
property also known as Sectional Zoning Amendment 1012:

Parcels 1 and 2 of tentative Division of Land 913.  
James Ramsey

SECTION II:

The Board of Supervisors based its decision on the  
findings specified in exhibit A.

SECTION III:

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the  
expiration of thirty (30) days from and after its passage, and it shall become  
effective on the 3rd day of October 19 79, and before  
the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, it shall be published  
in the County of Calaveras.
