

Prohibiting the Depositing, Dumping or Burning of Refuse, Waste or Garbage
Upon or near any of the Highways of the County.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit, dump or burn any
refuse, waste or garbage, of any kind, upon any of the roads, streets, lanes,
bridges or other highways of the County of Calaveras, or within ten feet thereof.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be
guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than
five dollars nor more than fifty dollars.

Section 3. this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the
first day of April 1905, and before taking effect shall be published for one week in
the Calaveras Chronicle a weekly newspaper published in said County.
